Evangelii Gaudium Sunday: The theme this year is *I believe*. This is because the Church has been celebrating the 1,700 year anniversary since the great gathering of Bishop met at Nicaea to discuss how to formulate the Creed that we say every Sunday. We always begin by saying: *I believe*. This Sunday we focus on the Mission of the Church to evangelise in our own country. We are called to live and speak the Joy of the Gospel first of all to people of no faith and then also to Catholics who have lost touch with the Church. We all need to be evangelised every day to ensure that the light of faith within us burns strong.

Pope Francis proclaimed "We cannot forget that evangelisation is first and foremost about preaching the Gospel to those who do not know Jesus Christ or who have always rejected him. Many of these are quietly seeking God, led by a yearning to see his face... Christians have the duty to proclaim the Gospel without excluding anyone." Evangelii Gaudium Today there is a Second Collection which provides the bishops of England and Wales with resources to support Home Mission, the spread of the gospel in our own country.
