Parish Mass Count: It was pleasing to see that the average Mass attendance over the four Sundays was much increased on 2024: an increase from 257 to 314. We are seeing new people coming to our parish but at the same time some families have stopped coming for whatever reason or coming less frequently. Our thanks to the collectors for counting the numbers so well. On looking at the averages for each Mass it is interesting that our 5.30pm Mass on Sunday evening is more popular than previously, although there is fluctuation during the year. So, this year the average was 79. The average for 10.30 was 156 and the average for 8.30am was 78. Thank you for being faithful to Sunday Mass.

November is the month of the Holy Souls when we pray especially for those of our loved ones who have died. Envelopes are available in the porch for you to place inside the names of your loved ones you would like us to pray for. Please place these in the basket at the foot of the altar. There is no need to enclose any money but if you do, it will be used for Masses for the Holy Souls. If you want a Mass intention for a particular member of your family, then please use the usual Mass Intention envelopes.

New Bishop for Plymouth: At long last Pope Leo has appointed a new Bishop for Plymouth Diocese: Mgr. Nicholas Hudson. He was brought up and went to school in Wimbledon which makes him a Southwark priest. He also helped with the large Scout group at Sacred Heart, Wimbledon. He attended the Venerable English College in Rome where he eventually returned to as Rector. He was an assistant priest in Canterbury where he became very involved in the l'Arche Community there, as did fr David Standley. He was in charge later on of what was then known as The Christian Education Centre in Tooting Bec. Most recently he has been Assistant Bishop in Westminster Archdiocese. He is a very genial, gentle and warm priest with many gifts. Fr Michael has known him for a long time and he has always been helpful in the parish when you needed guidance about parish programmes. Apologies if I have given wrong information as I am relying on my memory. Our prayers go with him as he starts a new and important ministry in a very large and scattered Diocese. Saint John Henry Newman: on All Saints' Day, Pope Leo will declare Saint John Henry Newman to be a Doctor of the Church. He joins a select group of saints noted for their wisdom and powerful teaching. Hope this is ok. We may receive something more official.
